Dexamethasone Suppression Test

An appointment is necessary for this test

Your doctor has referred you to have a Dexamethasone Suppression test.

This test involves having a baseline blood sample taken the first morning, taking 1mg of Dexamethasone tablets at night, and having a second blood sample collected the next morning.

Day 1

Please have your baseline blood test taken between 8 and 9 am at your most convenient collection centre. Please phone the collection centre for an appointment prior to attending to allow us to have the Dexamethasone available when you arrive.

1mg of Dexamethasone is supplied by Capital Pathology. This is packaged as two 0.5mg tablets.

Please take the two tablets at 11 pm on Day 1.

Day 2

Please attend your most convenient collection centre to have a second blood test taken between 8 and 9 am.

No appointment for this test is necessary; however please make yourself known to collection staff as your blood specimen needs to be taken between 8 and 9 am.
